Holiday Art Competition

Highlight your artistic talents while contributing to the quality of your community and its waters by submitting an image for Greater Gallatin Watershed* Council's (GGWC's) 2010 holiday card!

The competition is open to professional and amateur artists of all ages, for holiday card artwork that includes some type of water element (e.g., snow, icicles, stream, etc.), capable of being produced as 5"x7" printed cards. Style may be classic, contemporary, or whimsical. No text is necessary. \$600 in cash will be awarded to the top three winning artist(s), and the top 10 entries will be displayed (with artist info) at the Bozeman Angler during the Christmas Stroll and during GGWC's January annual meeting and auction. Submittals are due July 30th, 2010.

Join us for the second annual holiday tradition to support the greater Gallatin community and GGWC's efforts to keep our streams clean and healthy.

Competition Details:

1. Each contestant may submit a maximum of 2 entries.
2. Each entry must be an original work of art.
3. Artwork of any medium (e.g., photography, painting, illustration) is acceptable, as long as it will effectively reduce down to 5"x7".
4. Entries must be received by 5 pm on on July 30th, 2010. Mail or deliver original art to GGWC Board Member Doug Fletcher at:

5. Official signed entry form and short artist biography not exceeding 500 words must accompany each entry.

Winners will be selected by the GGWC Board of Directors and invitees based on quality of art, inclusion of a water element, and breadth of appeal for local holiday card sales. . Winners will be notified by August 31st, 2010. The top three submittals will become the property of GGWC for reproduction in the 2010 Holiday Card Contest and will be entered as lots during the GGWC Annual Silent Auction, January, 2011. The next seven submittals will be considered honorable mention. The honorable mention submittals will be retained by GGWC through December 31st, 2010 for display during holiday art displays.

*A watershed is an area of land that drains to a river at a specific point. The Greater Gallatin Watershed encompasses all lands that drain to the Gallatin River at Logan or any of its tributaries – both mountains and lowlands.
